PROCLAMATION IN OBSERVANCE OF SUDDEN UNEXPLAINED DEATH IN CHILDHOOD AWARENESS MONTH

Whereas, Sudden Unexplained Death in Childhood (SUDC) is a category of death in children, between the ages of 1 and 18, that remains unexplained after a thorough investigation, including an autopsy; and

Whereas, currently, we do not know what causes SUDC, how to predict it, or how to prevent it; and

Whereas, SUDC is a devastating tragedy that remains poorly understood and often underrecognized; and

Whereas, hundreds of families are impacted by SUDC every year; and

Whereas, raising awareness of SUDC is critical to promoting resources, advancing research, and helping prevent these heartbreaking losses; and

Whereas, the State of Delaware joins friends, advocates, and families in recognizing the importance of understanding SUDC and honor the lives lost to SUDC.

Now, Therefore, I, Matthew Meyer, Governor, 'do hereby declare March 2025, as

SUDDEN UNEXPLAINED DEATH IN CHILDHOOD AWARENESS MONTH

in the State of Delaware, and urge all residents to support research efforts and families impacted by SUDC.
